

Genesis 2:3 (January 3)

And God blessed the seventh day,
and sanctified it:
because that in it he had rested
from all his work
which God created and made.

Exodus 20:8,9 (January 10)

Remember the sabbath day
to keep it holy.
Six days shalt thou labour,
and do all thy work.

Exodus 20:10 (January 17)

But the seventh day
is the sabbath of the Lord thy God;
in it thou shalt not do any work,
thou, nor thy son, nor thy daughter,
thy manservant, nor thy
maidservant,
nor thy cattle, nor thy stranger
that is within thy gates.

Exodus 20:11 (January 24)

For in six days
the Lord made heaven and earth,
the sea, and all that in them is,
and rested the seventh day:
wherefore the Lord blessed
the sabbath day, and hallowed it.

Ezekiel 20:20 (January 31)

And hallow my sabbaths;
and they shall be a sign
between me and you,
that ye may know
that I am the Lord your God.

Luke 4:16 (February 7)

And he came to Nazareth,
where he had been brought up:

and, as his custom was,
he went into the synagogue
on the sabbath day,
and stood up for to read.

Matthew 12:12 (February 14)

Wherefore it is lawful to do well
on the sabbath days.

Mark 2:27,28 (February 21)

"...The Sabbath was made for man,
and not man for the sabbath:
Therefore the Son of man is
Lord also of the sabbath."

Isaiah 58:13,14 (February 28)

"If thou ... call the sabbath a
delight,
... and shalt honour Him,
not doing thine own ways,
... I will cause thee to ride upon
the high places of the earth"

Leviticus 23:3 (March 7)

Six days shall work be done:
but the seventh day
is the sabbath of rest,
an holy convocation;
ye shall do no work therein:
it is the sabbath of the LORD
in all your dwellings.

Isaiah 66:23 (March 14)

"... That from one new moon
to another,
and from one sabbath to another,
shall all flesh come to worship
before Me,
saith the Lord.
